And so, with that in mind, we left the city for the picturesque landscape of Aberfeldy and ventured north to Mains of Taymouth country estate.

At little over an hour's drive from Edinburgh, Kenmore is the antithesis of a bustling city; a quaint village set on the banks of Loch Tay with pretty surroundings, good food, golf, hill walking and highland safari on its doorstep. For those who prefer the harder stuff, Dewar's World of Whisky distillery, is a short trip away, is an education for mind and palate, and well worth a visit.

Self catering is the name of the game here and with well kitted out kitchens and barbecue areas in each garden you couldn't want for much more. Especially with the onsite delicatessen brimming with freshly baked bread, artisan produce and infused olive oils and vinegars to add some extra oomph to your culinary creations. Eating out is also an option though at the estate's Courtyard restaurant and bar; a good spot to read the papers and play board games as well as dine out.

A bubble of tranquillity, Mains of Taymouth is a place to enjoy some quality time together. And whether that's with friends, family or a partner, a stay here is recommended.
