Our Terms & Conditions are as follows:

- All dog/s must be kept on leads while on the Estate
- Guests take full responsibility for their dog/s at all times
- It is your responsibility to clean up any fouling after your dog/s throughout the Estate
- Your dog/s must not be allowed to disturb any other owners/guests on the Estate or any wildlife
- Please do not leave your dog/s unattended in the house at any time
- A maximum of 2 dog/s allowed per property
- Dog/s are not permitted on any furniture in the property including sofas, armchairs & beds
- Dog/s are not permitted in the bedrooms at any time
- If your dog/s is molting or is of a long haired breed, please be advised that each property is equipped with a vacuum cleaner for use throughout your stay to keep dog hair to a minimum in the accommodation. You are expected to ensure the property is free of dog hairs prior to departure
- In the event if your dog/s fouls or urinates in the luxury accommodation, please inform Reception immediately so we can attend to it
- Your dog/s must not cause any damage to any fixtures, fittings, furniture and contents of the property or anywhere on the Estate
